Language Requirements

Italian

Minimum level required: **A1**.

An **Entry Test** is required for Erasmus+ students.

English

Minimum level required: **B1**.

An official English language certificate is required for Erasmus+ students attending courses taught in English.

GPA Requirements

There is no minimum GPA requirement to participate in the exchange programme. However, some courses may have specific prerequisites that students must meet.

Course load

The standard workload is 30 ECTS credits per semester. The University of Macerata (UniMC) offers courses at both Bachelor's and Master's level.

Choosing courses

The University of Macerata primarily offers [courses in Italian](#), while some departments also provide [courses in English](#).

Exchange students are expected to prioritise course selection within the department to which they have been nominated. All courses are open to both exchange students and regularly enrolled degree-seeking students, subject to any specific prerequisites.
